VNSNY CHOICE SelectHealth Expands to Westchester and Nassau Counties

We're thrilled to announce that VNSNY CHOICE SelectHealth is now the first and only Medicaid special needs plan in New York State operating outside of New York City.

We're delighted to bring Westchester and Nassau providers into our dedicated family of physicians, social workers, community organizations, hospitals, clinics and designated AIDS centers serving our members.

Effective immediately, Medicaid-eligible patients in the expanded areas can be enrolled in SelectHealth if they qualify.

Medicaid-eligible individuals living with HIV, identifying as transgender (whether or not they are HIV+), living in a homeless shelter (whether or not they are HIV+)—and those individuals' children—may be eligible to enroll in VNSNY CHOICE SelectHealth if they live in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, Nassau or Westchester.

Key features of the plan

- No prior authorization for HIV medications
- Steps for a Healthier Life program, which offers rewards—more than \$500 a year—for healthy actions members take. For example, keeping their viral load undetectable (below 200 copies/ml) earns members \$100 each quarter
- SelectHealth provider sites are also rewarded each quarter \$125 for each member who keeps their viral load undetectable

How should an interested patient enroll in SelectHealth?
