## PrEP to Prevent HIV and Promote Sexual Health

If your patient is HIV negative, **Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP)** is a safe, daily pill that protects them from HIV. It's a powerful tool in helping to *End the AIDS Epidemic* as well as to help them take control of their sexual health.

Studies have shown that PrEP is safe and reduces the risk of getting HIV from sex by about 99% when taken daily (CDC). The New York State Department of Health AIDS Institute has released guidance and other resources for PrEP which you can find here.


